

DATA PROTECTION POLICY

USERS/ CUSTOMERS

Persons accessing the GPX Technology CC or its affiliate website Rydz.mobi and who make use of the products and service offerings, subject themselves to and agree to GPX Technology CC terms conditions and privacy policy, as set out below.

1. INTRODUCTION

We respect your privacy and take it very seriously. We are, GPX Technology CC and this is our plan of action for the protection of your personal information. It describes how we collect, use, disclose, and store your personal information.

2. APPLICATION

This policy applies to you when you visit the GPX Technology CC or its affiliate website Rydz.mobi use the products or services as a customer.

3. PERSONAL INFORMATION

3.1 We collect the following personal information: -

3.1.1 Your full name;

3.1.2 Identity number

3.1.3 Address

3.1.4 Contact information;

3.1.5 Location information;

3.1.6 Vehicle information.

3.2 We obtain such personal information by the following means: -

3.2.1 When you log into our website or use the GPS tracking platform;

3.2.2 Upon acceptance, on registration or submission;

3.2.3 through an order; or

3.2.4 provided voluntarily by you

3.3 You may only send us your own personal information or someone else's personal information if you have their permission to do so.

4. ACCEPTANCE AND CHANGES

4.1 You may not order any of the products or services if you do not accept this policy or any changes to it.

- 4.2 We may change this policy at any time and will notify you of the changes on our website, through GPX Technology or Rydrz.mobi, or by email. The changed policy applies to you if you continue using our website, or the products or services following the notification.

5. COLLECTION

- 5.1 The site automatically collects your Internet usage information (including your IP address, browser details, and usage information) through your browser, which we may use to display our website correctly, track your activities on it, or for other necessary purposes.
- 5.2 When you use the products and services, the site automatically collects your application usage information (including your operating system version and other relevant system information) through analytics software and other technologies, which we may use to optimise our offering to you.
- 5.3 The site may ask you to provide certain identifying information (including your first name, surname, and email address) when you register on or otherwise submit information through the applicable site for the first time.
- 5.4 We ask you to provide us certain personal information (including your first name, surname, contact information, email address, and banking details) when you order our products or services.

We may ask you to provide us certain optional information on a voluntary basis.

5.5 Consent to collection

You consent to us using, collecting, processing, and storing your personal information in accordance with applicable law.

5.6 Lawful Purposes

We may use, collect, and process your personal information that you provide to us for the purposes for which it was collected and agreed with you, such as:

- 5.6.1 Legitimate business purposes, in order to provide you with the products and services we offer.
- 5.7 In addition, where necessary your information may be retained for legal or research purposes, such as: -
- 5.7.1 To gather contact information;

- 5.7.2 To confirm and verify your identity or to verify that you are an authorised user for security purposes;
- 5.7.3 For audit and record keeping purposes;
- 5.7.4 In connection with legal proceedings.
- 5.7.5 Processing includes gathering your personal information, disclosing it, and combining it with other personal information.
- 5.7.6 All personal information processed by a responsible party must be done on one of the following bases: consent; contract; legal obligation; vital interests ;legitimate interests.

6. USE

6.1 Processing

We may process your personal information to fulfil our obligations to you i.e. for legitimate business purposes.

6.2 Cookies

We may place small text files on your device when you visit our website that allow us to provide you with a personalised experience by associating your personal information with your device. They let us remember your preferences, allow third parties to provide services to you, and otherwise serve useful purposes for you. Your internet browser generally accepts them automatically, but you can often change this setting or delete them manually. However, we won't be able to provide you with access to certain aspects of our website where cookies are necessary if you do so. We have no access to or control over any cookies that our business partners use on our website and they have their own privacy policies that govern them.

6.3 Messages

We may use your identifying information to send you administrative and update messages about GPX technology or Rydrz.mobi.

6.4 Promotional messages

We will not send you promotional messages unless you have chosen to opt into them. We may send you one message asking you to opt into promotional messages without you having opted into promotional messages.

7. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

7.1 We may share your personal information with third parties with whom we contract for the purposes of fulfilling our obligations to you, including with:

7.1.1 other companies or divisions within our group;

7.1.2 our contractors who help us meet our obligations to you, including those that help us understand your personal information; or

7.1.3 to provide our ongoing service to you; or

7.1.4 third parties as required by applicable law.

7.2 We will require anyone that we share your personal information with to honour this policy whenever possible in terms of applicable law to ensure that personal information that we remain responsible for, is kept secure.

7.3 We may also disclose your information, where we:

7.3.1 have a duty or right to disclose in terms of law or industry codes

7.3.2 believe it is necessary to protect our rights.

7.4 Marketing purposes

7.4.1 We may disclose aggregate statistical information that we derive from your and other people's personal information to our advertisers or business partners.

7.4.2 We may need to disclose personal information to our personnel to do their jobs but will not do so unnecessarily.

7.4.3 We may assign our rights to the personal information we process to our new owners if our ownership changes for any reason.

8. SECURITY

We take the security of personal information very seriously and always do our best to comply with applicable data protection laws. Our website and cloud service are housed in a secure server environment that uses a firewall and other advanced security measures to prevent interference or access from outside intruders. We implement disaster recovery procedures where appropriate.

9. STORAGE

9.1 You may ask us to provide you with a description of the personal information that we hold on you, correct or update it or delete it (provided that we do not need it to fulfil our obligations to you or applicable law does not require us to keep it). We will take all

reasonable steps to verify your identity before doing so. We may charge a fee to recoup our costs associated with this request if there is a cost to us associated with it and provided that applicable law allows us to do so. Please contact us with your name, and a copy of your identity document in order to identify you correctly if you want access to information or want us to correct, update or delete it.

- 9.2 We will do our best to keep your personal information that we collect accurate, complete, and up to date.
- 9.3 We may ask you to update your personal information from time to time but will take steps to verify your identity to prevent unauthorised access when doing so.
- 9.4 We will only keep your personal information for as long as is necessary to fulfil our obligations to you, unless you have given us permission to keep it longer or we are otherwise legally allowed to do so.
- 9.5 Transfer. We may transfer your personal information outside of the country in which it was collected to a foreign country. You consent to us processing your personal information in a foreign country with less stringent data protection laws than the country in which it was collected.

10. GENERAL

You may update or remove your personal information through our website or application; or by contacting us.

11. LIMITATION

We are not responsible for anyone else's privacy policies or practices.

12. BREACH

In the event of a breach of security leading to the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure of, or access to, personal information we shall promptly assess the risk of the data subjects' rights and freedoms and if appropriate report the breach to the Information Regulator as soon as possible.
